

## Minutes of the September 2004 Fun Time Virginia Aero Nuts RC Club Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 9:10am by Robert Vest. Both Shelley and Jess were away at work and could not make the meeting.
- **Visitors-** No visitors.
- **Communication-** Robert gave a report on the possible frequency conflict at the new field. At the moment, the steel plant is using 4 frequencies for their crane operation. This could affect 8 of OUR RC channels. At this time we should **NOT** fly on channels **21, 22, 23, 24, 34, 35, 38 and 39** while out at Full Circle Solutions. This is Robert's opinion only and does not reflect the feeling of the board. (The board has not officially met and or decided anything on this yet) We may have further information soon that will tell us if there is a problem or not.
- **Reading of the August Minutes-** Robert read the minutes from the August business meeting. John Walker made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Rodney Tolley second the motion. The motion was passed by those present.
- **Treasurers Report-** Robert Vest read the treasury report.
- Dudley Walker made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and it was seconded by John Walker. The motion was passed by those present.
- **Old Business-**

  - There wasn't any further business so Dudley Walker made a motion to adjourn and it was second by John Walker. We were dismissed at 9:35 am.
