

## *June 2005 Meeting Minutes*

### *Communications*

- Virginia EAA fly-in at the Petersburg/Dinwiddie Airport is October 1 & 2. A Hanover RC club is supposed to put on a flight demo.
- Rob mentioned to the member that may not already know our web address. There are maps and directions to the flying field and to Dave Wright's house on the site.
- Hobby Town USA opens June 10<sup>th</sup> with a grand opening of 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> the address is 8032 B West Broad Street.
- Dave Wright has taken and passed to required test to become a contest director.

### *Minutes*

- John Walker read the minutes from the May meeting. Bruce Hutchinson made a motion to accept the reading and it was seconded by Joe Vest. The members present passed the motion.

### *Treasury Report*

- Willie Jackson made a motion to accept the treasury report and it was seconded by Jess Robertson. The members present passed the motion.

### *Old Business*

- The club mower has a new pulley and solenoid. I think all it needs now is the frame welded and it should be available again for grass cutting.
- The weed eater for the club is temporarily on hold.
- The next day for the club fly day is Saturday June 18<sup>th</sup>. Rob also stated that if anyone wanted to send out an email and try to get a group together on a different day like Shelley had done they are more than welcome.
- Shelley mentioned in the past about the club becoming an IMAA Chapter. Give this some thought and we will wait to get more information from Shelley and the July Meeting.

### *New Business*

- Full Circle report. Dave stated that Full Circle would provide us with a scoop of dirt to be used as fill in some of the low spots on the taxi ways and pit areas. He also said that Full Circle would smooth out the area when you make the left heading up to the field.
- The gate at Full Circle is to be locked at all times when the Full Circle staff is not on the premises. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- We have a brand new handicapped accessible port a john now at Full Circle. The cost is \$?? Per month to the club.
- The new frequency/radio impound board has been installed at the field.
- The 4 pilot stands are installed and easily removed for cutting.
- The board is still working on getting some more items for the field. Frequency checker, 1 more wind sock, 5 more plane stands, first aid kit, fire extinguisher, and signs at entrance. Also give some thought to place a line down the center of the runway.
- Give some thought to having an open house for the Full Circle staff and their families.

- New field safety requirements - The radios you plan to use that day are to be placed in the impound and removed only when you have your frequency pin. No taxing in the pit area. Kill your engine before entering the pit area. Pilots are to stand behind the pilot stations when flying. No stepping over any fencing. Smoking allowed only in the spectator/parking area.
- We are working on a "new member" packet for those who join our club.
- Club member cards were handed out to some, but they had the wrong year on them. I have the new cards (with the right year) printed and will bring them to the next meeting.

### **Club Time**

- Rob passed out CD's full of pictures (over 2,600) from the Joe Nall fly in this year.
- Ron Baker gave a demo of Dave's CNC foam cutting. That was pretty slick to see in operation.
- The drawing for the \$10 Hobby Corner gift certification was one by a visitor Tom Kerr.
