

Minutes of the March 2005 Fun Time Virginia Aero Nuts RC Club Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 9:13am by Shelley Moore.
- **Visitors-** None. Charlie had a membership application and money from Ron Baker who wanted to join. Dave has been teaching Ron to fly and he attended our Christmas dinner.
- **Communication** – Shelley wanted to thank everyone for their support during his term as President. This club was formed some 15 months ago and he has enjoyed it. Shelley also said that he wanted to recognize a particular individual in our club that has gone the extra mile. He is there to help people with questions, building techniques and flying help. He has helped many in our club to solo. Shelley presented Dave Wright with a plaque. The plaque had the clubs plane logo on it and looked very nice. There was inscription on the plaque also. Robert also reminded everyone about the up coming Joe Nall event.
- **Reading of the February Minutes** – Robert read the minutes from the February Meeting. John Walker made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Rodney Tolley second the motion. The motion was passed by those present.

Treasurers Report- Robert wanted to let the group know about a couple matters. The club wrote a check to Jess Robertson in July of 2004 (check # 1007) to pay for the porta john for that month. The check was lost and never cashed. Robert stated that as of this month, he added that money back into the check book. That amount will be applied to his family membership dues for 2005. - **Old Business-**

- **New Business-**

The AMA also requires the owner to put his information on his aircraft or the AMA may not cover a claim involving said aircraft. There being no further business, Dave Wright made a motion to adjourn.
